## REVIEW OF THE 2017 SEASON

It was expected that at the end of the 2016 season, where the club had struggled with three league sides, and had taken the reluctant decision to withdraw from the North Essex Cricket League after 40 seasons in that competition, that administration and playing availability would improve in 2017. However, the 2017 season was perhaps the most difficult adult season for a number of years, with availability a major problem affecting both teams. A reciprocal relationship developed with Great Horkeley & Lexden, where a number of their players turned out for West Mersea on a Saturday, and vice versa on a Sunday was a positive. The Junior section, particularly the Under 11s is also looking very strong, and the All Stars section run by Steve Daines proved to be very successful. However, the problems in the senior teams are all too clear, not enough quality 15 to 40s committing to regular cricket, through one reason or another, whilst the over 40s who regularly play are not able to put in consistent competitive performances to challenge other 'younger' sides in league competition. Both sides finished in the lower reaches of their respective Two Counties divisions, the first team eventually finishing bottom of Division Six, and suffering their first relegation. While the Second team were once again battling for the wooden spoon, eventually finishing second bottom. However, despite their lowly positions in the league tables both teams did actually beat the champions of their respective divisions, to show that on their day and with full strength sides they could beat almost anyone. Overall the club won just 10 of their 35 completed matches, and lost 22, which represented a win percentage of 29%. A further two matches were conceded by West Mersea due to lack of players, while a single victory was achieved as a result of an opponents concession. Seventy Three players represented the adult sides in 2017, of which 19 were guest players. Only 13 players played ten or more matches, which highlighted the availability issue. There were 22 debutants in the season, of which 11 were guest players. There were significant reductions in games for a number of key players to the club, Luke Bruce (4), Neil Goodridge (0), Chris Graham (4), Nick Gray (1), Kevin Hewes (1), Darren Hewett (4), Mel Hughes (0), Dan Lambert (3), Angus Lockhart (1), James Tilsley (1), Trevor Vince (0), Matt White (3), Matt Wilkin (5) and Cameron Williams (2) - all through one reason or another played considerably less games than they have done in previous seasons. Individually for the first time since 1998 no player passed 500 runs, with the highest scorer for the club being Ian Young with 497. Young's average of 41.42 saw him top the club batting averages for a record ninth time. David Taylor (381), Adam Rutter (327) and Luke Conway (324) were the only other players to top 300 runs. Just six bowlers took in excess of ten wickets, with the club's leading wicket taker being Luke Conway with 26 wickets, the next best was Steve Smith and Darren Rumble each with 15. Steve Smith topped the club's bowling averages for the first time, his wickets being taken at 15.53 a piece. There were two centuries in 2017, with the highest being a career best for David Taylor, 141 at Braintree seconds. There were also just two five wicket hauls, with Allan Highfield returning the best of the season with 6 for 37 against Maldon 4ths. Career best's were also achieved for Rory Green, 100 not out against the Rain Men, Jason Hoggarth 86 against Braintree seconds and Allan Highfield 47 against Boxted. Allan also recorded a career best with the ball with his 6 for 37, while Henry Gayton (4 for 30), Amit Tiwari (4 for 31), Dan Lambert (3 for 32) and Elliott Drage (3 for 35) also recorded individual best performances with the ball. Career milestones were reached by Mick Laver, 950 appearances and 13000 runs, Graham Pryke 800 appearances and 11000 runs, Ian Young 14000 runs, Adam Rutter 9000 runs, while Darren Rumble became the 12th Mersea bowler to claim 500 wickets. In the 35 matches played Mersea scored 4909 runs for the loss of 262 wickets, while the opposition scored 4932 runs, with Mersea bowlers taking 182 wickets. The highest Mersea score of the season was a massive 338 against Braintree seconds in August, which proved to be not enough as Braintree eased to three wicket win. Eight Mersea batsmen achieved two centuries and 16 fifties during the 2017 season, with Jason Hoggarth, Adam Rutter and Ian Young each scoring four fifties. The smallest return of six hits since 1999, saw just 45 maximums scored by 14 players.

## REVIEW OF THE 2017 SEASON

Luke Conway topped the Six Hit list for the thirteenth successive season although his tally of 14 was considerably lower than his usual quantity, and he was hard pressed by both David Taylor and Jason Hoggarth, who both hit ten. There were 66 ducks during the season, of which 10 were first ballers. The most crucial one was a first ball of the match claimed by Rory Green against West Bergholt, which ultimately saw him claim the Mallard Trophy. Steve Daines also finished with six Mallard points, but Green claimed the Mallard by virtue of the Diamond Duck against Bergholt. There were six century partnerships, with the best being a 145 second wicket stand between David Taylor and Jason Hoggarth against Braintree. There were a further 19 fifty run partnerships. Taylor was the most consistent partner appearing in eight of the 25 biggest partnerships. Adam Rutter and David Taylor were the most successful pairing putting on 274 runs together at an average of 45.67. Jason Hoggarth with six outfield catches was the most successful outfielder, while David Taylor was the leading keeper with nine dismissals (8 catches and one stumping)

### TWO COUNTIES FIRST ELEVEN

Availability was a significant factor in the First Eleven's struggles in Division Six, with the season getting off to the worst possible start with a concession in the opening game of the season, followed by a six wicket and nine wicket defeat, to see the side bottom of the table with just four points after three games. Victories in the next two games, including an unlikely two wicket win at West Bergholt where Matt Wilkin scored an unbeaten 45 from his number nine berth to clutch victory from defeat, saw Mersea close the gap on the other sides in the lower reaches. However, four defeats in the next four games then saw them cut adrift at the half way stage of the season. The second half of the season began better, with four victories in five matches to again give hope that relegation could be avoided. One of the victories came at home to eventual champions Stowupland when Mersea battled to a ten run victory, largely due to the efforts in the lower order from Tom Sanderson, who scored an unbeaten 43 as Mersea recovered from 111 for 8 to 172 all out. However, the season ended with another run of four defeats including a soul destroying defeat at Braintree on the 12th August, to cement bottom place and relegation. In the game against Braintree, the islanders has posted a superb 338 with David Taylor (141) and Jason Hoggarth (86) leading the way, however, on a road of batting track, Braintree managed to chase the target down with three wickets and six balls in hand. Just four players played ten or more matches in the sixteen games completed, captain Luke Conway (16), David Taylor (15), Tom Sanderson (13) and Jason Hoggarth (10), as the side used 36 players, of which ten played just a single game. David Taylor (381) was the top scorer for the side, with Adam Rutter (327 at 40.88, topping the TC 1st XI batting averages), Jason Hoggarth (302 at 37.75) also topping 300 runs. Both Rutter and Hoggarth compiled four half centuries in the competition. All rounder, Luke Conway was the next highest scorer with 262, but was the leading wicket taker with 23 wickets at 24.65, which saw him top the Bowling averages for TC 1st XI. Steve Smith (12 in five games), Darren Rumble (11) and Tom Sanderson (10) were the other players to make double figure returns. David Taylor was adjudged TC 1st XI Player of the Year for the second time, for his performance with the bat and taking eight dismissals at the wicket. He also became the second Mersea player to pass a landmark 3000 runs in the Two Counties league. Other landmarks saw Luke Bruce pass 1500 runs, Luke Conway reached 150 appearance and David Taylor and Matt Wilkin both reached 100 appearances. A treble of landmarks for Tom Sanderson saw him make his 50th appearance, score his 500th run and take his 50th wicket.

## REVIEW OF THE 2017 SEASON

### TWO COUNTIES SECOND ELEVEN

The Two Counties second eleven side were again locked in their annual battle with Maldon 4ths for the Wooden Spoon at the bottom of the league structure. By virtue of a mid season double over their Blackwater rivals they managed to secure bragging rights for a third successive season and avoided the spoon. Mersea's two other victories were achieved over third placed Witham 3rds in June, and on the last day of the season a one wicket victory over a depleted Coggeshall 3rds side who had claimed the title a few weeks earlier. Just one match was lost to a concession, Mersea having to concede to Harwich & Dovercourt in August, while both matches against West Bergholt 2nds were abandoned due to rain - the home game surviving just two balls. While the game at Eight Ash Green in June had to be cancelled due to a 'Traveller' invasion on Fordham Heath. That meant there were eight defeats on the field for the side, with some more competitive performances than in previous seasons, which was a positive. Perhaps the most disappointing performance of the season was a one run defeat at home to Kelvedon 3rds, where Mersea having got themselves into a winning position having bowled the visitors out for 118. Henry Gayton and Mick Laver both claimed four wickets a piece. Incredibly, in reply Mersea were restricted to 117 for 9 in 42 overs.

Individually the stand out performer for the side was Ian Young, who scored a TC 2nd XI record of 464 runs, including four fifties, at an average of 58.00, which saw him top the Batting Averages for TC 2nd XI. He was also the leading fielder for the side with four catches, and his performance with the bat went a long way to see him claiming the TC 2nd XI Player of the Year award. Mick Laver (153), Graham Pryke (124) and Peter Phillips (118) were the only other players to top 100 runs in the campaign. Mick Laver (11) was the leading wicket taker for the side, and topped the TC 2nd XI Bowling averages. Amit Tiwari (9) was the next best return, with Rosie Daines and Allan Highfield each taking six - Highfield's coming in one bowling spell as he took 6 for 37 against Maldon 4th. Mersea bowlers only managed to take 77 wickets in the 12 matches completed, which showed the lack of teeth in the bowling department.

The side used 41 players during the season, of which Steve Daines (10), Jonathan Hewett (11), Mick Laver (11), Graham Pryke (10), and Ian Young (12) were the only players to reach double figures in terms of appearances. No less than 19 players played just a single game for the side, which again underlined the availability issue within the club.

Career landmarks saw Ian Young and Rory Green both pass 500 runs for the side, while Amit Tiwari became the first Mersea players to pass 50 wickets for the TC 2nd XI and Jonathan Hewett made his 50 appearance for the team.

### CLUB

Away from the playing side there were plenty of off the field events that kept club members occupied throughout the year. The Golf Day at Maldon in April was once again a great success, with half the profits being donated to MND on behalf of Jason Hoggarth's father Steve, who sadly passed away later on in the year. The Annual General Knowledge Quiz, hosted by the Hughes family, was as always a festival of brain power and proved enjoyable for all those who attended. The club hosted a Ladies Cricket Festival, labelled Prosecco Cricket in the middle of the year, which was successful and will be replayed in 2018.

All Stars Cricket started in May and had an extended run through into July, for 5 to 8 year olds starting out in the sport. Steve Daines, directed this new initiative for the club and was deservedly awarded the Club Person of the Year. A Kwik Cricket festival was held in the middle of June, and as ever the club hosted very professionally. The Annual Summer Camp was held at the beginning of August, and provided three days of cricketing skills and games for youngsters on and off the island. The Rain Men fixture provided the ladies with an opportunity to put on one of their magnificent after match feasts, which did not disappoint.

There was no formal cricket dinner this year, just a Presentation evening for Colts and Adults held at The Glebe. Nevertheless, the first such venture proved successful with the added promotion of the Division County Championship trophy being displayed with our own trophies.

## REVIEW OF THE 2017 SEASON

### PLAYERS OF THE SEASON

**IAN YOUNG** - Adapted to life in the TC 2nd XI, by scoring a record 464 runs for that side to top both the Club Averages (for a record ninth time) and the TC 2nd XI Batting Averages. He scored four fifties in his overall aggregate of 497, which was the highest return by a Mersea player in 2017. He claimed the TC 2nd XI Player of the Year award in his first full season playing for that side.

**JASON HOGGARTH** - came of age with the bat in 2017, with four fifties in a haul of 302 runs in ten TC 1st XI innings. This included a career best 86 from just 37 balls against Braintree 2nd, which included five sixes. He was a deserved winner of both the Young Player of the Year, and Best Performance of the Year by a Young Player

**DAVID TAYLOR** - was top scorer for the TC 1st XI scoring 381 runs at an average of 25.40, this included the highest score of the season for the club, with his sixth century for the club and his biggest, 141 against Braintree 2nd. David was also the leading fielder, taking eight catches and a stumping for the TC 1st XI.

**ADAM RUTTER** - although playing just half the games in the TC 1st XI, Adam was again a consistent performer with the bat, scoring four half centuries in his haul of 327 runs, which saw him top the Batting Averages with an average of 40.88

**LUKE CONWAY** - by his own high standards not the best of seasons for Luke, but he still managed to score 324 runs in 19 innings, and top the Six Hits charts for a thirteenth successive season with 14 maximums. He was the leading wicket taker in the club with 26 wickets, 23 for the TC 1st XI which saw him top the Bowling Averages for that side.

### 2018 SEASON

The new year has not got off to the best of starts with the sad news of the unexpected passing of Mike Snow on New Years Eve. Although playing barely fifty games for the club, Mike was an effervescent character who often brought laughter to any situation he was in.

The Two Counties first team will begin life in Division Seven of the League with a later start this season, starting on the 5th May at Frinton, before making a trip to Maldon on Bank Holiday Monday, 7th May. Hopefully this will afford some early season availability to ensure the side makes the best possible start to the campaign. However, with a baby boom occurring in the club, a number of regular first team players from previous seasons, are undoubtedly going to find regular commitment difficult. So it may be a year of consolidation in Division Seven. The fixture list does provide a welcome return of the local rivalry with Abberton, as Mersea take on their second string in May and August. The Two Counties second eleven start their campaign on 12th May, with a home match against Earls Colne, followed a week later by a visit from pre-season favourites Chappel & Wakes Colne. Development remains key to the second team, with older colts hopefully making the transition into a senior cricket.

There will be no less than four double headers at The Glebe in 2018, which although challenging logistically, do allow for a certain amount of club camaraderie. Opposition for these games have already been invited to stay afterwards with the barbeque fired up.

There will be plenty of opportunity for youth cricket, with All Stars again running from June to July, Summer Camp in August and several friendlies set up for the Under 13s. Training will also take place regularly on Tuesday evening to improve and skills, and above all make the game fun.
